

**CELEBRATION OF HISTORY MONTH 2025 AND IMPLEMENTATION OF PROJECT
TUTOK SIKHAY SOKSAY**

To: **ASSISTANT REGIONAL DIRECTOR
SCHOOLS DIVISION SUPERINTENDENTS
CHIEF EDUCATION SUPERVISORS, CLMD AND CID
ALL OTHERS CONCERNED**

1. By virtue of Proclamation No. 339, s. 2012, the entire month of August is designated as **History Month** in recognition of significant events in the country's history that occurred during this period, including **National Heroes Day**, the **anniversary of the Cry of Pugadlawin** and the **Battle of San Juan del Monte**, as well as the birth and death anniversaries of various national heroes and presidents.
2. In solidarity with the **National Historical Commission of the Philippines**, the DepEd MIMAROPA Regional Office, Schools Division Offices (SDOs), and schools are encouraged to conduct activities in commemoration of the rich history of their localities and of the Philippines.
3. Guided by the theme "**Diwa ng Kasaysayan, Kabilin sa Kabataan**" (*Spirit of History, Heritage for the Youth*), the following are suggested activities to be implemented until the last day of August 2025:
 - a. Announcing the importance of celebrating History Month during flag-raising ceremonies in offices and schools;
 - b. Displaying on bulletin boards significant historical events of the locality and of the Philippines;
 - c. Sharing written essays, poems, or other creative works honoring national or local heroes;
 - d. Providing trivia on the history and culture of the locality and of the Philippines; and
 - e. Conducting other meaningful activities related to the celebration of History Month.
4. In addition, the **Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD)** will implement **Project TUTOK (Talino at Ugnayan Tungo sa Organisadong Kahusayan) SIKHAY SOKSAY**, which aims to strengthen participation in the National Festival of Talents (NFOT) and other national competitions by organizing quarterly contests across the seven Schools Division Offices. One of the main focuses of this project is the conduct of quarterly school-level and district-level contests, including **Impromptu Speech, Population Quiz, and Kasaysayan Quiz**. The leadership and coordination of Division Araling Panlipunan Supervisors, in collaboration

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with Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDS) and school heads, are crucial for the successful implementation of this project.

5. In line with the implementation of Project TUTOK SIKHAY SOKSAY, the following activities shall be conducted at the school and district levels until the last week of September 2025:

Grade Level	Activity
Grade 6	Kasaysayan ng Pilipinas Quiz Bee
Grade 10	Population Quiz Bee
Grades 11-12	Impromptu Speech

**The activities may be conducted through face-to-face or virtual modalities.*

6. Division accomplishment reports shall be submitted to the CLMD through the Division Araling Panlipunan Supervisor. These reports must include the list of winners for each contest at the school and district levels. The results will serve as the basis for the Regional Office in identifying students who will undergo training for various contests prior to the conduct of the Division and Regional Festival of Talents, which is one of the key components of Project TUTOK SIKHAY SOKSAY. Schools and districts may refer to DM 039, s. 2025 – *National Schools Press Conference and National Festival of Talents* for detailed guidelines and contest mechanics.
7. The consolidated reports from school-level and district-level contests must be submitted by the Division Araling Panlipunan Supervisor on or before **October 3, 2025**, via email at mimaropa.region@deped.gov.ph, cf: clmd.mimaroparegion@deped.gov.ph.
8. All offices and schools are likewise encouraged to document and report their activities and share them on their official platforms, such as their respective social media pages or websites, using the following hashtags:
