



CONDUCT OF THE 1ST DEPED MIMAROPA REGION CURRICULUM FAIR 2025

To: **ASSISTANT REGIONAL DIRECTOR
SCHOOLS DIVISION SUPERINTENDENTS
CHIEF EDUCATION SUPERVISORS, CID AND CLMD
ALL OTHERS CONCERNED**

1. In pursuit of the Department of Education's thrust to advance quality, inclusive, and responsive curriculum implementation, the Department of Education MIMAROPA Region, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), shall conduct the **1st DepEd MIMAROPA Region Curriculum Fair 2025 on October 14–17, 2025, in Puerto Princesa City, Palawan**, as a landmark regional initiative that underscores the Region's commitment to strengthen curriculum delivery, highlight innovations, and foster collaboration among education leaders and stakeholders.
2. With the theme **"Strengthening Curriculum Futures through Leadership and Advancing mAlnstream Innovations in Education"**, this regional fair is designed to inform and equip participants with updates on the directions, programs, and activities of the Learning System Strand. It will highlight curriculum innovations, teaching strategies, and contextualized learning resources developed by schools and divisions across the region in support of the implementation of the revised curriculum. Moreover, the fair will serve as a venue for education and school leaders to engage in dialogue, exchange insights, and collaborate on evidence-based approaches to curriculum delivery. It will also facilitate the assessment and enhancement of classroom practices to ensure their alignment with the objectives of the revised curriculum through interactive exhibits and knowledge-sharing sessions.
3. The activity shall feature plenary sessions on curriculum delivery improvements and future directions, alongside an integrated exhibit and breakout sessions under INNOvated, which will showcase select innovations in various learning areas and institutionalized DepEd programs.
4. Participants in this activity shall include personnel from the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) such as Chief Education Supervisors (CES), Education Program Supervisors, Public Schools District Supervisors, Education Program Specialists, Division Librarian, Project Development Officer II. In addition, selected school heads and teacher-leaders are also encouraged to attend this activity.

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5. To ensure smooth preparation and organization of the event, the CID CES are requested to facilitate the submission of the list participants and designate a personnel to encode the names of their official participants through the designated link <https://tinyurl.com/Curriculum-Fair-Participants> on or before October 3, 2025 (Friday), 3:00 PM. Each SDO is provided with an assigned sheet and must ensure that entries are encoded only in the corresponding SDO sheet. The allotment of participants per SDO is specified in Enclosure I.
6. In addition, the CLMD, in collaboration with the Policy, Planning, and Research Division (PPRD), has evaluated and identified research-based curriculum innovations to be presented under INNOvatED: Presentations of Curriculum Innovations. Existing and ongoing initiatives were screened and reviewed, and only those demonstrating strong potential for scalability and replicability were selected. The presenters of these innovations are considered additional participants beyond the official SDO allotment, and their complete list is provided in Enclosure II of this issuance.

Furthermore, since certain CID personnel have already been identified as presenters under INNOvatED, each SDO must fully utilize its allotted slots to ensure that opportunities are provided to other qualified participants.
7. Check-in for participants shall be on October 14, 2025, at 2:00 PM, with afternoon snacks as the first meal. Check out shall be on October 17, 2025, at 12 noon with lunch as the last meal. Requests for early check-in shall not be accommodated.
8. The Registration and Opening Program shall be on October 14, 2025, at 2:00 PM, while the Closing Program shall be held in the morning of October 17, 2025. To maximize the benefits of the Curriculum Fair, participants are expected to attend the entire duration of the event.
9. Expenses for this activity, including the board and lodging of participants, shall be charged against the SNED, ADM, and ALS Continuing and Current Funds, while travel expenses of participants shall be charged against available local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
10. In addition, the travel expenses of SDO Education Program Supervisors in charge of IPEd, as well as school heads of IPEd-implementing schools who are participants in this activity, shall be charged against Division IPEd Funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
