

1. Research presentation must follow the prescribed format below and in PowerPoint presentation:

For Basic/Action Research:

- I. Title of Research (Title, Researcher/s Name, School and District) (1 Slide)
 - II. Brief Introduction/Rationale (include background of the study) (2 Slides)
 - III. Conceptual Framework (1 Slide)
 - IV. Research Questions (1 Slide)
 - V. Research Methodology (1 Slide)
 - a. Design
 - b. Sampling
 - c. Data Collection
 - d. Data Analysis (statistical tool being used in the study)
 - VI. Findings/Conclusion/Recommendations (in tabular form) (maximum of 8 Slides)
 - VII. Implications for Practice or Policy (How the results of your study can be applied or used in real-life educational settings) (1 Slide)
2. A 10-min research presentation shall be given to research presenters.
 3. Actual instruments and intervention materials used in the study may be presented for the perusal of the panelists/board of judges.
 4. The presenter/presenters shall be given three (3) minutes to answer each question from the members of the board of judges.
 5. Group Research members are required to be presenters.
 6. Completed copy of the research must be submitted to the School Governance and Operations Division – Planning and Research Section on or before November 20, 2025. (5 hard copies)
 7. Schools Division Research Committee Members including the Technical Working Group and Division Statisticians shall serve as panelists/board of judges.
 8. Dress Code: Corporate Attire

MECHANICS ON THE RESEARCH POSTER PRESENTATION

1. Research proponent/presenter will prepare tarpaulin (5ft x 2 ft) in portrait layout.
2. Each research poster must include the following key sections:
 - a. Research Title
 - b. Research Proponent/s, School and District Assignment
 - c. Brief Introduction/Rationale (include background of the study)
 - d. Conceptual Framework
 - e. Research Questions
 - f. Methodology
 - g. Findings/Results
 - h. Conclusions and Recommendations
 - i. Implications for Practice or Policy (How the results of your study can be applied or used in real-life educational settings)
3. Dress Code: Corporate Attire

MECHANICS ON THE PRESENTATION OF EXEMPLARY RESEARCH AND INNOVATION PRACTICES

1. Each presenter shall be allotted **10–15 minutes** to present their research or innovation.
2. Presentations should focus on:
 - Title of the research
 - Problem or issue addressed
 - Objectives
 - Methodology or process of implementation
 - Key results and impact
 - Lessons learned and recommendations
3. A **PowerPoint presentation or poster** is required to support the sharing.
4. After each presentation, a **5-minute open forum** will follow for questions and clarifications.
