



**CALL FOR NOMINATION FOR THE 2026 METROBANK FOUNDATION
OUTSTANDING FILIPINOS – TEACHER AWARD**

Per invitation received on November 10, 2025 from The Metrobank Foundation, this Office calls for the **nomination for The 2026 Metrobank Outstanding Filipinos – Award for Teacher** until **January 23, 2026**.

This program is an annual recognition for ten (10) Filipino exemplars – four teachers, three soldiers and three police officers who have gone over and beyond the call of duty to serve their profession and their community.

Authorized nominators can submit eligible **nominees** who are **public and private elementary school teachers** including those who are in kindergarten level provided it is a part of integrated curriculum and **high school teachers** including those who have full load in Alternative Learning System (ALS).

To ensure that all Schools Division Offices (SDOs) are well-represented in the search, all DepEd schools divisions are encouraged to submit a minimum of three nominees (one elementary, one secondary and one ALS) comprised of either private or public school teachers.


