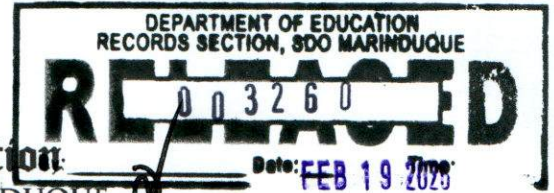

In reference to the communication from the Gokongwei Brothers Foundation (GBF) STEM Collab, this Office reiterates to all concerned personnel the FREE webinar series in collaboration with ChildFund Philippines and SEAMEO Innotech, in support of the Department of Education's ARAL Program. The webinar, titled *ARAL Series: Master Class on Social-Emotional Learning (SEL) for Remediation*, will be conducted on February 14, 21, and 28, 2026, starting at 8:00 AM via Microsoft Teams Townhall. This three-part series is intended for Key Stage 1 ARAL Teachers and Tutors and aims to strengthen educators' understanding and application of the ExSELLEnT: Contextualized Social and Emotional Learning (SEL) Competency Framework for Filipino Learners, particularly in supporting remediation efforts.

Each session consists of synchronous discussions and self-paced workshop activities, with a total of 24 learning hours (eight hours per session). Participants may earn up to 15 Continuing Professional Development (CPD) units, granted to the first 80,000 Licensed Professional Teachers (LPTs). 
