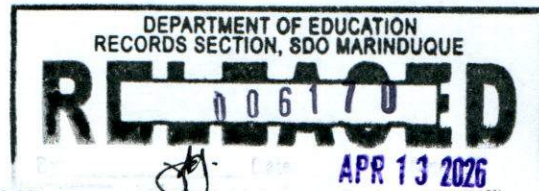

**VIRTUAL REVISION, FINALIZATION, AND KUMUSTAHAN ON THE STATUS OF ENHANCEMENT OF QUALITY-ASSURED LOCALIZED STORYBOOKS WITH FILIPINO SIGN LANGUAGE (FSL) INTEGRATION**

1. In line with the Division's commitment to inclusive education and as a continuation of the Enhancement Workshop on the Integration of Filipino Sign Language (FSL) in Quality-Assured Storybooks and Multimedia Stories conducted on March 2-5 and 7, 2026, this Office hereby announces the virtual revision, finalization, and Kumustahan on the Status of Enhancement of the developed learning resources.

2. This activity aims to (1) ensure the completion and refinement of FSL integrated localized storybooks, (2) address quality assurance (QA) feedback and technical requirements, and (3) monitor the overall progress of enhancement prior to final QA certification and dissemination.

- Submission of revised and final outputs shall follow the prescribed file naming conventions, formats, and timelines to be issued by the Technical Production Lead and QA Team.

6. No additional expenses shall be charged to the government as this activity shall be conducted virtually.
