4. The identified participants and resource speakers are reminded to bring their own medical maintenance, laptops, chargers, extension cords, and other sources of internet connectivity. Furthermore, they are expected to be in their respective training venues on the morning of Day 1. Late arrivals and early departures are strictly not allowed.

5. Transportation, per diem, and other incidental expenses shall be charged to the 2026 HRD Fund and other SubAROs intended for the Revised Grades 6, 9, and 10 Curriculum training activities, subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. **They shall coordinate with the School Governance and Operations Division – Human Resource Development Section (SGOD-HRDS) for the proper and timely preparation of their required travel documents.**

6. Teachers whose attendance in authorized activities falls on a weekend, holiday, class suspension, or during the school break shall be entitled to vacation service credits, subject to existing rules and regulations, pursuant to DepED Order No. 013, s. 2024, while non-teaching and related-teaching personnel shall be granted compensatory time-off pursuant to existing CSC-DBM guidelines, provided that no per-diem is received. Travel time shall not be excluded from the computation of compensatory time-off credits.
