**UTILIZATION OF LOCALLY DEVELOPED AND VALIDATED TEACHING
RESOURCE PACKAGE (TRP) IN GOOD MANNERS AND RIGHT CONDUCT
(GMRC) AND VALUES EDUCATION (VE)**

1. Pursuant to the Division initiated Project VALUES (Valuing Attitudes of Learners through Unified Efforts of Stakeholders) and following the successful field validation conducted on May 7, 2026, this Office announces the official utilization of the Locally Developed Teaching Resource Package (TRP) in Good Manners and Right Conduct (GMRC) and Values Education (VE).
2. The Teaching Resource Package (TRP) is explicitly designed to support teachers in implementing the learning area effectively. It is composed of the following components:
 - a. Module Explainer for the Eight (8) Pedagogical Approaches in GMRC/VE – providing comprehensive theoretical and practical frameworks for value integration; and
 - b. Daily Lesson Log (DLL) – serving as a structured guide for systematic and standardized classroom delivery.
3. These resources have been quality-assured to ensure they are pedagogically sound and strictly aligned with the standards of the Revised K to 12 Curriculum. The utilization of the TRPs aims to:
 - a. standardize the delivery of GMRC and VE instruction across the division using the 8 specific pedagogical approaches;

b. provide teachers with validated, culturally responsive, and curriculum-aligned materials; and

c. enhance the character development of learners through the core principles of Project VALUES.

4. School Heads are directed to ensure that all GMRC and VE teachers in their respective jurisdictions have access to these validated TRPs. Implementation shall cover the prioritized grade levels: Elementary (Grades 3, 5, and 6) and Secondary (Grades 7, 8, 9, and 10) however, other grade levels (Grades 1, 2, and 4) are also encouraged to utilize the TRPs which can be accessed through the link: <https://lrms.depedmarinduque.com/>.

5. The Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) shall conduct periodic monitoring to gather data on the effectiveness of the materials. Teachers are encouraged to provide feedback on usability and student impact.

6. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum are desired.
