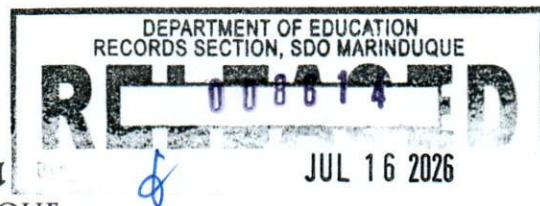

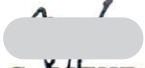

TITLE: **DISSEMINATION OF DEPED ORDER NO. 6, S. 2026, TITLED
"GUIDELINES ON ENSURING A SAFE AND MOTIVATING LEARNING
ENVIRONMENT"**

DATE: July 13, 2026

1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 69, s. 2026, all concerned are hereby informed on the implementation of DepEd Order No. 6, s. 2026, titled "Guidelines on Ensuring a Safe and Motivating Learning Environment.
2. The Order consolidates and harmonizes existing policies on learner rights and protection and strengthens the implementation of preventive and responsive measures against bullying, violence, abuse, discrimination, and other child protection concerns in schools. It also provides guidance on school safety, incident management, intervention services, and learner support mechanism.
3. All public and private elementary and secondary schools in the Schools Division of Marinduque are hereby directed to strictly implement the provision of DepEd No. 6, s. 2026 particularly the following:
 - a. formulate, disseminate, implement, and regularly review the School Code of Conduct and Learner Handbook;
 - b. adopt and implement a localized Anti-Bullying Policy consistent with the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 10627 (Anti-Bullying Act of 2013);
 - c. strictly enforce the prohibition against hazing and fraternities/sororities pursuant to Republic Act 11053 (Anti-Hazing Act of 2018);



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- d. implement school safety and security measures, including visitor management, inspection procedures, regulation of portable electronic devices during instructional hours, and other security protocols;
 - e. develop and implement school-specific Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) aligned with DepEd-prescribed response mechanism; and
 - f. strengthen intervention programs and support services, including guidance and counselling, psychological first aid, mental health and psychosocial support, and other learner protection services
4. School Heads shall ensure the immediate dissemination and faithful implementation of this Order among teaching and non-teaching personnel. They shall likewise monitor compliance and submit report or other required documents as may be directed by this Office.

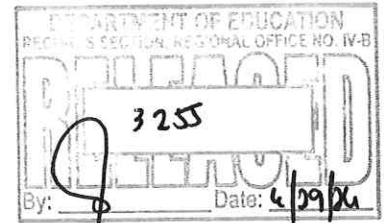

DISSEMINATION OF DEPED ORDER NO. 6, S. 2026, TITLED "GUIDELINES ON ENSURING A SAFE AND MOTIVATING LEARNING ENVIRONMENT"

1. The Department of Education (DepED) MIMAROPA Region hereby disseminates DepEd Order No. 6, s. 2026, titled "*Guidelines on Ensuring a Safe and Motivating Learning Environment.*"
2. This Order consolidates and harmonizes existing issuances on learner rights and protection and aims to address incidents of bullying, violence, and other forms of abuse in schools through preventive and responsive measures. These include the implementation of security protocols, reporting and incident management procedures, and the provision of appropriate interventions and support services.
3. In line thereto, all public and private elementary and secondary schools are directed to adopt and implement the provisions of this Order, particularly the following:
 - a. **School Protocols** – Formulation, dissemination, implementation, and regular review of the School Code of Conduct and Learner Handbook.
 - b. **Localized Anti-Bullying Policy** – Adoption and implementation of a localized Anti-Bullying Policy by all public schools and Community Learning Centers (CLCs) in accordance with the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA No. 10627, otherwise known as *Anti-Bullying Act of 2013*.
 - c. **Prohibition of Hazing and Fraternities/Sororities** – Strict enforcement of the prohibition against all forms of hazing pursuant to Republic Act No. 11053 or the *Anti-Hazing Act of 2018*.

- d. **School Safety and Security Measures** – Implementation of visitor management guidelines, routine and random bag inspections, confiscation of prohibited items, vehicle and item inspections, installation of closed-circuit television (CCTV) systems and other security equipment, engagement of security personnel, and regulation of the use of portable electronic devices during instructional hours.
 - e. **Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs)** – Adoption and observance of school-specific procedures aligned with the general response strategies prescribed by DepEd. Simplified process flows are provided in Annexes A, B, and C of the Order.
 - f. **Intervention Programs and Services** – Provision of appropriate interventions for learner protection concerns, including psychological first aid, guidance and counseling services, mental health and psychosocial support, and other relevant assistance.
