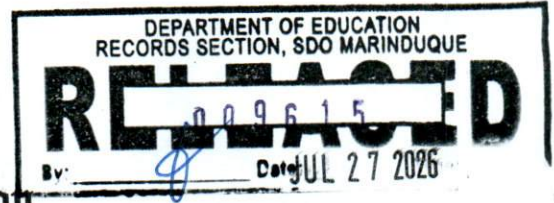

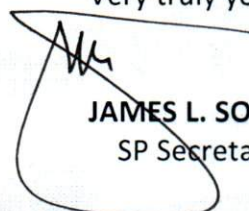

**RESOLUTION
ENACTING PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 266
SERIES OF 2026**

WHEREAS, the Office of the President has directed the implementation of the Basic Education Facilities (BEF) Program by the Department of Education, in coordination with the concerned Local Government Units, and has likewise ordered the release of BEF funds intended for the construction of classrooms and other education-related infrastructure projects nationwide;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan Joint Committee on Rules, Laws, and Ordinances, Committee on Education, Culture, and Arts, and the Committee on Public Works and Infrastructure found it imperative to review and amend Provincial Ordinance No. 193 s. 2022, otherwise known as the 2M4ED Ordinance, in order to streamline the process of availment of the program and to avoid duplication of projects already funded by other government programs;

WHEREFORE, be it *ENACTED* by the 17th Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Marinduque in session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. The title of Provincial Ordinance No. 193 s. 2022 is hereby amended to read as follows:

“AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE GRANT OF TWO MILLION PESOS (P2M) PROJECT ASSISTANCE TO EACH OF THE SIX (6) COMPONENT MUNICIPALITIES OF THE PROVINCE OF MARINDUQUE TO SUPPORT THEIR RESPECTIVE EDUCATION-RELATED INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS, PROVIDING GUIDELINES IN THE AVAILMENT THEREOF, AND FOR OTHER RELATED PURPOSES, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 193 S. 2022.”

SECTION 2. New Paragraphs 5 & 6 in Section 2 of Provincial Ordinance No. 193 s. 2022 are hereby inserted after paragraph 4 of the same reading as follows:

“SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF PRINCIPLES AND LEGAL BASIS.

Recently, President Ferdinand R. Marcos, Jr. ordered the release of funds for the construction of classrooms nationwide to the Department of Education (DepEd) under the Basic Education Facilities (BEF) Fund of the approved General Appropriations Act (GAA), that will be implemented by DepEd and the concerned local government unit.

In order to provide for a streamlined process in the availment of the 2M4Ed Program and to avoid duplication of projects, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan deemed it imperative to amend Provincial Ordinance No. 193 s. 2022. xxx

Paragraph (6) xxxxx

SECTION 3. Section 3 of Provincial Ordinance No. 193 s. 2022 is hereby amended to read as follows:

“SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION OF FUND. – Aside from the Special Education Fund (SEF), there is hereby allocated in the 20% Development Fund of the Provincial Government of Marinduque an Annual Project Assistance of Two Million Pesos (P2M) to each of the six (6) component



municipalities of the province to support their respective education-related infrastructure projects. For this purpose, education-related infrastructure projects shall mean "construction, renovation, and repair of school buildings and facilities, excluding administrative buildings and offices."

SECTION 4. Section 4, Paragraphs 1, 3, and 4 of Provincial Ordinance No. 193 s. 2022 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 4. GUIDELINES FOR AVAILMENT. -The project assistance for LGUs herein provided shall be exclusively used by the municipality concerned to fund, support, and/or augment their respective education-related infrastructure projects, which could be availed through: xxx

xxx

1. A request to finance a pre-identified education-related infrastructure project from the Local Chief Executive (LCE) of the municipality concerned, upon the recommendation of the Department of Education (DepEd). xxx
2. The project/s to be financed by the herein project assistance shall be included in the province's Annual Investment Program (AIP). It shall likewise be included in the AIP of the respective municipalities.
3. The concerned Sectoral Committee on the Provincial Development Council (PDC) shall make the necessary evaluation on whether the project to be financed by the herein project assistance is compliant with the intent of this Ordinance and recommend to the Provincial Governor the course of action to be undertaken. Should the Local Finance Committee find the project non-compliant, the same should be communicated to the requesting LGU for them to make the necessary rectification. xxx
4. The LGU may request project assistance for multiple projects, provided that it does not exceed the amount being appropriated by the province per LGU.
5. xxxxx

SECTION 5. Section 5, Paragraphs 3 and 4 of Provincial Ordinance No. 193 s. 2022 is hereby deleted so that Section 5 of the Ordinance will now read as follows:

"SECTION 5. PROHIBITIONS ON THE USE OF THE PROJECT ASSISTANCE. -The financial assistance herein given to the LGUs shall NOT be used:

1. For any purpose other than the project(s) previously identified by the LCE concerned, including the location thereof, for which the fund was released;
2. To fund projects already fully covered by the other sources of funding."

SECTION 6. Section 6, Paragraph 2 of Provincial Ordinance No. 193 s. 2022 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 6. PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION. -The education-related infrastructure project/s identified by the concerned municipality shall be implemented by the Provincial Government of Marinduque.
