For the information and guidance of all concerned, this Office disseminates the following attached communications:

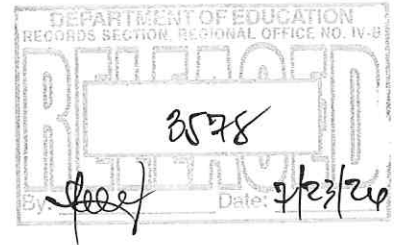
