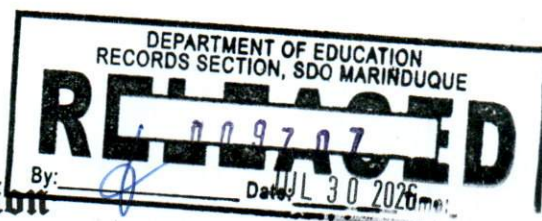

1. Attached is Memorandum HRDD-2026-093 from the Office of the Regional Director, Dr. Ronnie S. Mallari, CESO III, dated July 20, 2026, titled "*Call for Nominations to the Learning Initiatives for Nurturing Guidance Associates and Counselors Program (LINGAP)*," which announces the call for nominations to the said scholarship program under the Commission on Higher Education (CHED), in partnership with the Department of Education, through the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP), with the following program details:

Program Title	Learning Initiatives for Nurturing Guidance Associates and Counselors Program (LINGAP)
Qualifications	a. a Filipino citizen; b. teaching or non-teaching personnel employed on a full-time basis who have rendered at least 2 years of service in DepEd; c. have obtained at least a Very Satisfactory performance rating for the last two (2) rating periods; d. must be enrolled or willing to enroll in a CHED-recognized Philippine Higher Education Institution under the Masters in Guidance and Counseling or Masters in Psychology program; e. physically fit to undertake and complete the scholarship program;



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	f. willing to execute a Return Service Agreement with DepEd; g. not more than 50 years old within the next six (6) months from the date of application; h. with no pending obligations from all previously government-awarded grants or scholarships; and i. willing to execute a written agreement to take the Licensure Examination for Guidance Counselors or Psychologists upon completion of the program.
Entitlements Covered	a. actual tuition and other fees; b. Php 30,000.00 monthly stipend for a maximum of three (3) academic years; and c. Php 150,000.00 thesis allowance to be released in two tranches.

2. This scholarship program aims to develop a pool of competent guidance professionals who will contribute to improving basic education, advancing inclusive education, and promoting the mental health and well-being of learners and educational communities.

3. **All interested teaching, related-teaching, and non-teaching personnel must meet the qualifications and submit the following documentary requirements, in person, to the SGOD-Human Resource Development Section through the OSDS-Records Unit, on or before August 5, 2026:**

- a. Letter of intent addressed to the SDS;
- b. Application Form, using the prescribed form;
- c. Updated and notarized Personal Data Sheet (PDS);
- d. Work Experience Sheet;
- e. Proof of outstanding accomplishments (relevant certificates);
- f. Photocopy of approved IPCRF for the past two rating periods;
- g. Updated service record with "for scholarship purposes" remarks;
- h. Certification of physical and mental fitness, using the prescribed form;
- i. Certificate of no pending administrative/legal charges;
- j. Accomplished and signed Workplace Application Plan;
- k. Accomplished general eligibility requirements/checklist;
- l. Scholarship clearance.

Templates for documentary requirements b and h are accessible through bit.ly/LINGAPScholarshipMdq, while documentary requirements k and l shall be accomplished in person by the applicant once submitted to the SGOD-HRDS on or before the deadline.

4. All nominees, regardless of sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, gender expression, marital status, pregnancy, physical features, impairment or disability, work-related injury, religious belief or activity, ethnicity, political belief, affiliation, or activity, shall be given equal opportunity to avail and attend L&D programs, including scholarship opportunities, to enhance competencies.

5. Applications may be disqualified due to various reasons such as, but not limited to, incomplete requirements, direct sending of requirements to NEAP-CO or MIMAROPA RO HRDD email addresses, discrepancies in documents, etc.

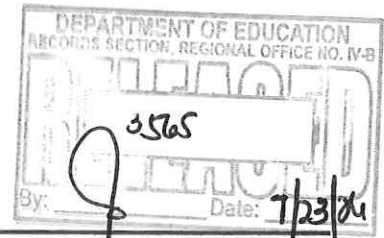

1. Pursuant to Republic Act No. 7722, otherwise known as the Higher Education Act of 1994, and in reference to Republic Act No. 12080, or the Basic Education Mental Health and Well-Being Promotion Act, and Republic Act No. 11650, or the Instituting a Policy on Inclusion and Services for Learners with Disabilities in Support of Inclusive Education Act, the Commission on Higher Education (CHED), in partnership with the Department of Education (DepEd) through the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP), hereby announces the Call for Nominations to the **Learning Initiative for Nurturing Guidance Associates and Counselors Program (LINGAP)**.
2. This initiative reflects CHED and DepEd's commitment to strengthening the capacity of the education sector by providing educational support to qualified teaching and non-teaching personnel who aspire to pursue graduate degree programs in Guidance and Counseling or Psychology. The program is aimed at developing a pool of competent guidance professionals who will contribute to improving basic education, advancing inclusive education, and promoting the mental health and well-being of learners and educational communities.



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3. LINGAP is a scholarship program open to **DepEd teaching and non-teaching personnel** holding permanent/plantilla positions who are either incoming or ongoing graduate students. Applicants must be currently enrolled in, or intend to enroll in, any of the following degree programs offered by CHED-recognized Philippine Higher Education Institutions (HEIs): **(a) Master's in Guidance and Counseling; or (b) Master's in Psychology.**

- a. The applicant must undertake and complete their degree program in an eligible graduate program offered by an HEI identified by CHED.
 - b. For incoming graduate students, LINGAP shall provide financial support up to three (3) academic years for the completion of the degree.
 - c. For applicants currently enrolled in an ongoing master's degree program, the allowable period for coverage shall be adjusted proportionately based on the remaining coursework units required to complete the degree. In no case shall the remaining duration of study applied for scholarship exceed the allowed years of scholarship provided which is three (3) academic years for the completion of the degree.
 - d. For applicants who are already in the thesis or dissertation writing stage, the allowable period for coverage shall be strictly limited to one (1) academic year.
4. Selected applicants shall be granted with the scholarship and are entitled to the following privileges upon approval of DepEd, subject to applicable provisions of the Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC).

4.1. The stipend shall be released on a per academic term basis, subject to compliance with the documentary requirements and to other government accounting and auditing rules.

4.2. The thesis allowance shall be released in two tranches based on the following schedules:

4.2.1. First tranche (80%) shall be released upon submission of certificate of approval for thesis proposal duly signed by the Dean and/or Department Chairperson.

4.2.2. Second tranche (20%) shall be released upon submission of the electronic copy of the approved thesis and approval sheet duly signed by the Dean, or equivalent.

Tuition and Other Fees	Actual tuition and other fees
Stipend	Php 30,000.00 x number of months per term
Thesis allowance	Php 150,000.00

4.3 In cases where scholars are approved while the term has commenced, the scholarship shall only cover the following:

- 4.3.1. Costs of tuition and other fees;

4.3.2. Stipend on the month of approval provided that it is approved within 20 days of the month of approval. In the event that the approval is made in less than seven (7) days from the end of the month, the stipend shall commence the next month.

4.3.3. Thesis Allowance

5. In this connection, all Regional Offices are hereby requested to endorse qualified nominees, ensuring equitable representation from the Schools Division Offices and adherence to the eligibility criteria.

Annex C

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

A nominated applicant shall be deemed eligible provided that all of the following conditions are met:

1. Must be a Filipino citizen;
2. Teaching or non-teaching personnel employed on a full-time basis and who rendered **at least 2 years of service** in DepEd. The minimum service period is imposed to ensure that scholarship support is extended to personnel with demonstrated commitment to public education and who are in a position to render meaningful return service upon completion of the program;
3. Must have obtained at least a **Very Satisfactory** performance rating for the last two (2) rating periods preceding the date of application.
 - 3.1 Must be admitted and enrolled in graduate degree programs identified in the Scope and Coverage of these Guidelines within the term of application;
 - 3.2 Must provide evidence of being physically fit to undertake and complete the scholarship program, as attested by a medical certificate issued by a licensed physician; and mentally fit to undertake and complete the scholarship program, as issued by a licensed psychiatrist or psychologist;
 - 3.3. Must execute a Return Service Agreement with DepEd, represented by the appropriate Regional Director concerned;
 - 3.4. Must be no more than 50 years old within the next six (6) months from the date of application, to ensure sufficient time to render and complete the return service obligation and imparting their acquired knowledge to the education sector;
 - 3.5. Must be cleared of any pending obligations from all previously government-awarded grants or scholarships, as attested by a Clearance or equivalent, including those in which the applicant was engaged as team members in research grants, or grants of similar nature; and
 - 3.6. Must be attested by the Sending SDO that the endorsement to the scholarship is part of the manpower development of the Division Office or its equivalent.
 - 3.7. Must execute a written agreement to take the Licensure Examination for Guidance Counselors or Psychologists, as applicable, upon completion of the program.

4. Additional requirement for applicants currently enrolled in ongoing master's degree programs:

4.1 Must be in good academic standing and not on extension of study at the time of application.

5. Ineligibility

5.1 Applicants with existing government-funded grants/scholarships, whether in partial or full, including those with an approved or received Notice of Award and/or executed scholarship/ grant contract at the time of application;

5.2 Applicants without clearance from previous awarded grants/scholarships, including those who served as team members on a funded grant;

5.3. Applicants who have been found guilty of administrative or criminal charges, or those with pending administrative or criminal cases;

5.4 Applicants enrolled in more than one graduate program at the time of application;

5.5 Applicants who have been terminated from a government scholarship due to non-completion, breach of contract and other analogous reasons;

5.6 Applicants who are unable to fulfill all of the eligibility requirements provided in these Guidelines, including, but not limited to, non-compliance or incomplete submission of documentary requirements.

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Annex G

REQUIREMENTS FOR SUCCESSFUL APPLICANTS

1. Successful applicants must formally communicate their acceptance of the scholarship and confirm their enrollment in the approved graduate program through written acknowledgement addressed to the CHED CO on or before the prescribed deadline.
2. CHED CO shall allow the submission of unaltered and electronically signed, generated and/or validated documents except the Application Form, Workplace Application Plan and Scholarship Contract and other documents requiring wet signatures, in accordance with applicable government accounting rules and issuances of the Commission on Audit (COA).
3. All LINGAP Scholars must obtain a Travel Clearance from DepEd and must submit a notarized Affidavit of Undertaking for both personal and official foreign travel. Failure to comply will result in automatic suspension.
4. During the suspension period, no scholarship benefits or financial assistance shall be released to the scholar until the suspension is lifted by the Graduate Scholarships Committee (GSC) upon full compliance with the prescribed requirements and clearance from the Program Management.
5. All LINGAP Scholars shall commit to complete their degree program within their approved study plan.
6. A LINGAP scholar must take a full academic load in line with the institutional policy and program study of the Delivering HEI (DHEI).
7. A LINGAP scholar may only take less than the minimum required units of academic load under any of the following conditions:
 - a. The remaining academic load in the curriculum prior to the thesis stage is under six (6) units;
 - b. The remaining term for thesis stage is under six (6) units as indicated in the program curriculum design or institutional policy; and



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- c. The term is designated to be enrolled under residency for the Comprehensive Exam, other similar exams, or during the Thesis Stage.
 - d. Scholars already enrolled in a graduate program before the commencement of the scholarship
8. Scholars are expected to complete their degree program, according to the approved study plan of the program.
9. The approved study plan is the study plan submitted by the DHEI to CHED upon admission to the program. Any changes to this study plan cannot be used as a basis for determination of financial privileges.
10. Scholars must undertake a return service obligation of two (2) years per year of scholarship received, or a fraction thereof¹ upon completion of the scholarship program.
11. Scholars, SDO, and DHEIs must maintain up-to-date profiles and provide all information required by DepEd and CHED in support of the smooth implementation of the scholarship.
