4. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

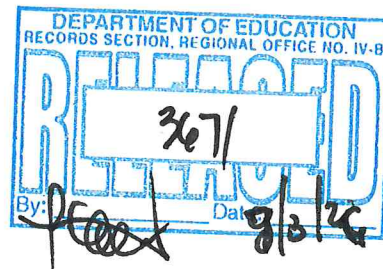

In reference to the received letter from the Regional President of National Association of Public Secondary School Heads, Inc. (NAPSSHI), Fred E. Magbanua, PhD, this office announces the conduct of the *15th NAPSSHI MIMAROPA Regional Congress* with the theme, **“Empowered School Heads: Leading Digital Transformation, Policy Innovation, and Well-being in the New Education Landscape”** from September 23-25, 2026, within Metro Manila.

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3. promote awareness and application of legal safeguards, administrative due process, and risk management to protect and empower school head; and
4. foster mental health awareness and psycho-social support systems among school leaders to sustain effective and resilient leadership.

A registration fee of Five Thousand Six Hundred Pesos (P5,600.00) to cover meals, training kits, venue rental, and honoraria of resource speakers, and Two Thousand Two Hundred Pesos (P2,200.00) for 2 days hotel accommodation. The sum of Seven Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (P7,800.00) shall be collected from each participant. The registration fee and travel expenses shall be chargeable against MOOE and other available local funds intended for the purpose, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Arrival and registration of participants will be on September 23, 2026, with afternoon snacks as the first meal to be served, while the last meal will be lunch on September 25, 2026. The dress code will be as follows:

- Day 1 – September 23, 2026-Filipiniana/Barong
- Day 2 – September 24, 2026-Formal Attire
- Day 3 – September 25, 2026-Conference T-shirt

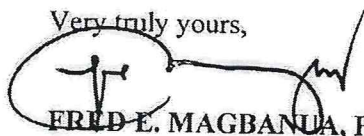
