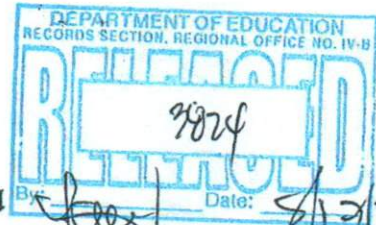

In line with the Department's continuing effort to strengthen the delivery of Special Program in the Arts (SPA), Special Program in Sports (SPS), and Music, Arts, Physical Education, and Health (MAPEH) programs, and to inform the planning and implementation of the Project PAKUDOS-Orukay activities for School Year 2026–2027, the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) shall administer a survey-questionnaire to gather relevant data, insights, and inputs from key stakeholders of arts and sports education across the region.

The survey-questionnaire shall be administered to the following respondents:

- Teacher-coaches handling arts and sports-related programs and activities;
- Department heads/coordinators and school heads of schools offering the Special Program in Sports (SPS) and the Special Program in the Arts (SPA);
- Schools (coaches, coordinators, and school heads) that represented the region during national-level competitions related to arts, culture, and sports (e.g., National Festival of Talents, Palarong Pambansa, and similar national competitions); and

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- d. Education Program Supervisors (EPS) in-charge of MAPEH, SPA, SPS, Arts and Design Track, and Sports Track.

The survey aims to (a) determine the current status, needs, and challenges in the implementation of arts and sports programs at the school and division levels; (b) gather feedback and recommendations from teacher-coaches and school heads directly involved in these programs; and (c) generate data that will guide the region in the planning, monitoring, and improvement of MAPEH, SPA, SPS, and related arts and sports initiatives.

In this regard, Schools Division Offices are enjoined to:

- a. Disseminate this Memorandum through official division communication channels to all schools offering SPS and SPA, teacher-coaches for arts and sports-related programs, and schools that represented the region in national competitions on arts, culture, and sports within their respective divisions;
- b. Facilitate the identification and accomplishment of the survey-questionnaire by the concerned respondents through the following link <https://bit.ly/pakudos-orukay>; and
- c. Ensure that all identified respondents accomplish the survey-questionnaire within the prescribed period to be indicated in the survey link.
