(Senior High School Category)

3. The context of the mobile photograph to be submitted must be aligned with the NDRM 2023 theme: **“BIDAng Pilipino: Building a Stronger Filipino Well-being towards Disaster Resilience”**.
4. The mobile photograph must have a short caption not exceeding 120 letters. English or Filipino may be used as the language.
5. The mobile photograph must be taken during the contest date and previously photo taken and published works are not eligible for submission.
6. Entries must use mobile phones only. Basic color correction may be applied but STRICTLY no heavy photo editing works.
7. The photos must be on a JPEG Format File with a minimum size of 1 MB.
8. All entries shall be submitted to the Organizers at the end of the contest proper.
9. By submitting an entry, participants shall agree to allow the LGU-Boac to reproduce, distribute, display, and create derivative works of the winning or non-winning entries for marketing, educational, and promotional purposes in media platforms at any time.
10. Photos will be judged on the following criteria:
 - a. Relevance to the theme - 30%
 - b. Creativity, Originality and Presentation - 50%
 - c. Audience Impact (based on the likes/votes that will be earned from Exhibit) - 20%
