In compliance to DepEd Memorandum No. ,s. 2023 titled: Learning Camp Reading Program Activities, this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division, informs the field of the administration of Comprehensive Rapid Literacy Assessment (CRLA) to Kindergarten pupils.

The objectives of this assessment are to collect data, assess Kindergarten pupils' status of readiness to enter grade 1, and identify appropriate reading programs for them during the learning camp.

The Beginning of the School Year (BoSY) CRLA tools shall be used by the Kindergarten pupils.

It is expected that technical assistance shall be extended by the CRLA-trained school heads and grades 1-3 teachers to the Kindergarten teachers during the administration of the Comprehensive Rapid Literacy Assessment (CRLA).

Uploading of assessment results into the system by the Kindergarten to Grade 3 teachers is expected to be undertaken ASAP for the planning of the learning camp activities by the schools for the incoming grade 1 pupils.

Meanwhile, analyzed results of the conducted CRLA tests for Grades 1-3 pupils are expected to be submitted to the Regional Office on or before July 7, 2023, for possible planning of intervention activities.



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Further, Division Action Plans based on the analyzed results are also expected by the Regional Office for monitoring and provision of technical assistance.
