



In reference to the Memorandum DM-CT-2023-168, the Office of the Undersecretary for Curriculum and Teaching requests for the commitment of the Regional Directors, Schools Division Superintendents and School Heads in putting up or maintaining an infrastructure that makes reading materials available for all learners to support the Department's thrusts in improving quality basic education.

Relative to this, the DepEd Central Office further reiterates to maintain the established Learning Resource (LR) facility in the Regional Offices (RO), Schools Division Offices (SDOs), and schools as it serves multipurpose functions on various LR processes and activities. **It is however emphasized that the top priority of all schools must be the use of rooms and other physical learning spaces as classrooms to comply with the standard class size and/or decongest classes for better learning environment.**

It is recommended to have the said LR facility be improved and organized for multipurpose use such as venue for collaborations, meetings, workshops and/or temporary hub of LR for distribution in the schools. In the schools, the LR facility is expected to cater to the day-today academic needs of the learners and teachers.

In this connection, Schools Division Superintendents and School Heads are requested to submit a commitment/response letter signifying the continuous support to Department's priority activities towards raising the quality of basic education in the country.
