




In 2012, the state mandated professional competitiveness and professional qualifications standards through E.O. No. 88, s. 2012 or the Philippine Qualifications Framework (PQF). In 2018, PQF was institutionalized by R.A. No. 10958 or the "Philippine Qualifications Framework Act". Further, in 2016, R.A. No. 10912 or the "Continuing Professional Development (CPD) Act" lapsed into law. CPD is also a requirement in most of the Professional Regulatory Laws of the regulated profession.

Since then, the enhancement of professional competitiveness was slowed down by various serious challenges such as, those in the political, economic, socio-cultural, technological, environmental and legal, and specifically climaxed by the pandemic.

We are in a pivotal shift from the pre-pandemic to the post-pandemic era. Professionals face challenges from various sources as the professional landscape constantly changes.
