Greetings in the spirit of humanity!

The Philippine Red Cross – Marinduque Chapter has been operating as a distinct and independent body engaged in massive humanitarian activities that promotes social values and is committed to provide quality life-saving services that protect the life and dignity especially of less fortunate citizens of the island province of Marinduque.

With the great amount of time that young and adults spend outside their homes, we have a high sense of responsibility to look after their safety and protect lives of every Filipinos.

The PRC Membership Program is a principal funding program that sustains the live-saving programs of the organization and aims to: (1) encourage the entire population of the Philippines to be Red Cross members regardless of citizenship, status, gender and political affiliation; (2) instill the value of giving and sharing for the benefit of the most vulnerable; (3) create a database of major corporate and individual partners and committed pool of Red Cross volunteers; and (4) generate funds to sustain the humanitarian efforts of the Philippine Red Cross.

With this, we are offering Membership Accident Assistance Benefits (MAAB) at a very low cost to all individuals, ages 5 to 85 years old regardless of status (i.e. students, out-of-school youth, unemployed, utility workers, executives, professionals, etc.).

The Membership Program offers coverage for 1) accident death, disablement and dismemberment; 2) unprovoked murder and assault; 3) accidental medical reimbursement; 4) burial benefit (accident); and 5) hospital daily allowances (maximum of 60 days), where amount of Premium Coverage varies depending on the Membership categories as attached.

Relative to this, may we request from your good office to support the enrolment of PRC National Membership and Fund Drive Program and encourage the students, teachers and all employees in your division to become a benevolent giver and participate in our humanitarian cause.
