

Pacing & Precision	Speaker appears comfortable, makes use of appropriate facial expressions & gestures	20%

VOICE OF THE YOUTH ORATORICAL CONTEST

THEME: "You(th) Create Hope in the World : A Youth's Beautiful Mind

LUZON LEG MECHANICS

Basic Criteria

- Open to any youth age 15 up to 25 years old.
- A contestant should be duly registered by a Rotary Club.
- Open to youth from all sectors including but not limited to members of Interact Club, Rotaract Club or any youth organization

ELIMINATION ROUND

- Submission of oration piece is until **March 01, 2024 Friday**
- Oration piece should be within the limit of the 5-minute oral presentation
- Basis of Scoring is on the criteria Content of Oration Piece 20%
- Announcement of Qualifying competing teams is on **March 4, 2024 Monday**.

Note: Competing team refers to the Orator and the Coach

NO. OF PARTICIPANTS

- Luzon Leg will have a minimum of six (6) to maximum of ten (10) competing teams
- The top two (2) teams of Luzon leg will compete for the grand prize of the National Championship scheduled on March 16, 2024 at PUP, Sta. Mesa, Manila

LUZON LEG CONTEST FINALS PROPER

- Luzon Leg Contest Finals is on **March 09, 2024 Saturday**
- Contestants shall deliver their 5-minute speech without a lectern.
- The use of microphone / lapel is not required.
- The 5-minute speech should be memorized. Notes and cue cards are not allowed in the presentation.
- The use of prompters, props, and special costumes, visual and audio-visual aids is not permitted. Singing, dancing, and dramatic presentation are also prohibited.
- Contestants shall present in business attire. Wearing of sandos, shorts, slippers, and the like are not allowed. Moreover, applicants may not wear any items that may identify their school such as school uniforms, IDs, and school pins.
- Contestants shall be judged on the speech content and on the delivery of their speech with the following criteria:
