

1. Relative to the implementation of DO No. 54, s. 2022, entitled "Guidelines on the Selection of Senior High School Technical-Vocational-Livelihood (TVL) Specializations," this Office through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division shall conduct the **"Strategic Sync: A Collaborative Model for Improving Senior High School Technical-Vocational-Livelihood (SHS TVL) Offerings"** from March 18 to April 29, 2024, at the venue which will be announced later.

2. Anchored to the guidelines which is designed to assist the Regional Office (RO), Schools Division Offices (SDOs), and schools in determining the TVL specializations to offer, aimed to align SHS TVL track offerings with students' preferences, school capacity, and development priorities, this inception initiative envisions to optimized workforce readiness, ensuring graduates possess skills directly aligned with industry demands for seamless transition into the workforce, contributing to economic development.

3. As part of the forthcoming submission to the RO of the Approved List of SHS TVL Specializations Offerings (first 5 Specializations per Strand) for the academic year 2024-2025 onwards, the Schools Division Office (SDO) Education Program Supervisor (EPS) overseeing TVL track will present the list, including Annex E inputs, to representatives from NEDA, PPDO/CPDO, and TESDA (**Enclosure 1: Table 2**). This presentation seeks shared insights that will play a crucial role in the approval process within the SDO, ensuring that decisions regarding specialization offerings are in alignment with regional development goals.

4. The onsite participants are the Education Program Supervisor in- charge of TVL, Science and SHS and the online participants are the School Heads of the SHS TVL Track Implementing schools. (**Enclosure 1: Table 3**)



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5. The provision for food allowance amounting to Four Hundred Forty Pesos (Php 440.00) per onsite participant will be charged against 2024 RO MOOE, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The amount will be downloaded to the concerned 7 SDOs.
