2024 DIVISION SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE

1. This Division, through the Curriculum Implementation Division shall conduct the 2024 Division Schools Press Conference (DSPC) on April 10-12, 2024 at Mogpog Central School, Mogpog District, Mogpog, Marinduque.

2. The Conference aims to:
- demonstrate understanding of journalism through skillful execution in various platforms (i.e., print, broadcast, online);
 - recognize the role of journalism in advocating for social consciousness and environmental awareness;
 - promote fair and ethical use of media as tenets of responsible journalism;
 - foster camaraderie and enrich learning experiences through healthy and friendly competitions; and
 - provide learners opportunities to use the skills learned in campus journalism for their future careers.

3. The participants/qualifiers eligible for the DSPC are the following:

Individual Categories	Top 2 district winners per medium/category
Group Categories	1 team /district per medium (Composed of 7 members each team except for online publishing with 5 members)
School Paper Category	Top 2 district winners per medium

4. All districts should ensure that schools participating in the DSPC have school paper publications in PDF or digital format.

5. The DSPC activities shall include the following:

6. Recognizing and respecting Intellectual Property Rights, the Department adheres to the rule concerning plagiarism. DepEd reiterates its stand to disqualify school papers found to have copied and published texts, graphics, and other materials without duly acknowledging their sources. The disqualification covers all sections of the school paper.

7. Any form of plagiarism in all competitions as proven by the board of judges shall be ground for disqualification.

8. The decision of the Board of Judges is **FINAL** and **IRREVOCABLE**.

9. A campus journalist can participate in only one event, either individual or Group category.

10. The top three (3) winners in all contest events (except for school paper) shall be recognized.

All expenses are subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
