2024 DIVISION YOUTH CAMP

TO: Asst. Schools Division Superintendent
Chief Education Supervisors
Public Schools District Supervisors
Public Secondary School Heads
All Others Concerned

1. Article 2, Section 13 of the Philippine Constitution states that “The State recognizes the vital role of the youth in nation-building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual, and social well-being. It shall inculcate in the youth patriotism and nationalism, and encourage their involvement in public and civic affairs”. Pursuant to this mandate, this Division through the Youth Formation Section in collaboration with the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) shall conduct a two-day **2024 Division Youth Camp**” with a theme, **EmpowerED: Leading the Way to Resilience, Substance Abuse Prevention, Environmental Awareness, and Disaster Preparedness** on July 25-26, 2024 at Freedom Eco Adventure Park, Bunganay, Boac Marinduque.

2. The said camp aims to attain the following:

- a. empower youth with the necessary skills and mindset to become effective leaders in their schools and communities;
- b. educate youth about the dangers of substance abuse and equip them with strategies to resist peer pressure and make healthy choices;
- c. foster a sense of responsibility and stewardship towards the environment, encouraging sustainable practices and conservation efforts; and
- d. equip youth with the knowledge and skills to prepare for and respond to various types of disasters, promoting resilience and community readiness.

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3. In line with this, all public secondary schools through the school heads and are requested to identify **two (2) student-leaders** (1 Youth for Environment in Schools Organization or YES-O Officer/ Member and 1 Barkada Kontra Droga or BKD Officer/ Member) who will participate in the said activity as **campers**.
4. In addition, each district through their respective Public Schools District Supervisors shall identify two **(2) teacher-advisers** (preferably 1 male and 1 female) per district who will serve as **Program Management Team (PMT) Members/Chaperones** of the campers.
5. Campers and teacher-advisers shall fill up the Pre-registration Form through the link <https://tinyurl.com/YouthCamPax> on or before **June 10, 2024**.
6. No Registration Fees shall be collected from the campers. Meals and accommodation of campers and teacher-advisers shall be charged to the Learner Formation (LF) Program Support Fund 2024, while supplies and materials of the camp shall be charged to the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) Program Support Fund. Travel expenses of campers and teacher-advisers shall be charged against school local funds or other funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulation.
7. Parent's/Guardian's Consent Form shall be accomplished and submitted to the Program Management Team (PMT) upon registration. Strictly **"No consent form, no camp"**.
8. An advisory will be released prior to the camp to further orient the participants on the camp's overall flow of activities and additional reminders.
9. Enclosed are the Activity Matrix and Parent's/Guardian's Consent Form.
10. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum is desired.
