

- c. The presentation focuses on the research results, conclusion, and recommendations.
- d. Each Presentation has 20 minutes allotted time;

Follow the prescribed outline and content of the presentation below:

OUTLINE	CONTENT
Title of the Study (1 slide)	Title of the study, researchers, workstation, Division Office
Introduction/Rationale/Background of the Study (1 slide)	Describe the problem or issue that inspires the researcher/s to conduct the study.
Statement of the Problem (1-2 slides)	Present the statement of the problem/ research objectives/ research questions.
Theoretical/Conceptual Framework (1 slide)	Present also the theoretical or conceptual framework being used in the study.
Methodology and Scope of the Study (1-2 slides)	Present the research design, methodology, respondents, research locale, and ethical consideration.
Research Findings (1-7 slides)	Present the findings in each specific research question or objective. Use graphic organizers (tables, graphs, etc.) or pictures to support your findings.



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Conclusion and Recommendations (1-3 slides)	Short conclusion synthesizing the findings. Specify recommendations based on the findings.
References (1 slide)	In bullet form, present relevant references used in the study.
