

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DEMO TEACHING MECHANICS

1. The event will be held virtually, participants are required to register through this google form, <https://forms.gle/bGmFmBNG5dTMttQr7>
2. A lesson plan must be submitted by the participants a week before the event, for evaluation.
3. A pre-recorded video of demo-teaching shall be submitted as the entry, teacher may choose to have it with learners (make sure with parent's permission or consent) or without.
3. The duration of the video should be within 30 minutes.
5. Each participant will be evaluated by different master teachers from different SDO's
6. The decisions of the evaluators are final, and irrevocable.
7. All demo teachers will receive the following:
 - an invitation letter address to their respective SDOs
 - Certificate of attendance
 - certificate of participation
 - certificate of evaluation indicated the scores obtained, signed by all evaluators
7. After the event, the panel of evaluators will choose the top 10 demo teacher, which will receive certificate as outstanding demo teacher.



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Demo teachers will be judged based on:

1. Content Knowledge: The teacher demonstrates a deep understanding of the subject matter, presents accurate information, and effectively conveys key concepts to students.	20%
2. Lesson Planning: The lesson is well-structured, with clear learning objectives, engaging activities, and appropriate resources to support student learning.	20%
3. Instructional Delivery: The teacher uses effective instructional strategies, engages students in active learning, and maintains a positive and inclusive classroom environment.	20%
4. Student Engagement: The teacher promotes student participation, encourages questions and discussions, and provides opportunities for all students to be actively involved in the lesson.	10%
5. Differentiation: The teacher differentiates instruction to meet the diverse needs of students, including varying levels of ability, learning styles, and interests.	10%
6. Time Management: The presenter adheres to the allocated time for the presentation, maintaining a balance between content delivery and audience engagement within the designated time frame.	10%
7. Technology Integration: the teacher effectively integrates technology tools and resources to enhance the teaching and learning experience.	10%
