








CONDUCT OF ACTIVITIES REITERATING MATATAG K TO 10 CURRICULUM STANDARDS AND COMPETENCIES AND CAREER GUIDANCE

1. As part of the MATATAG Agenda, the Department of Education has issued DepEd Order No. 010, series of 2024. This order outlines the Policy Guidelines for the Implementation of the MATATAG Curriculum, providing context and directions and articulating its features, designs, and standards.
2. The policy clearly defines its scope, articulating that *the MATATAG curriculum shall serve as the fundamental blueprint for teachers at the classroom level, help instructional leaders create supervisory and management plans to oversee instructional delivery, provide appropriate technical and other forms all assistance to teachers and school heads' and monitor learning gains, and that parents and other external education stakeholders shall be given direction and opportunity to support the MATATAG Curriculum in achieving its goals.*
3. In line with this, Schools Division Offices through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) are reiterated to direct all schools within their jurisdiction to devise measures in communicating the MATATAG Curriculum through its **Learning Area Grade Level and Performance Standards** to all stakeholders (e.g. parents, teachers, learners). These standards can be accessed through this link: <https://bit.ly/MATATAGStandards>.
4. Measures and/or activities may include but not be limited to the conduct of orientations, fora, conferences, among others. This is crucial for garnering support from all stakeholders in the successful implementation of the MATATAG Curriculum. Please refer to Enclosure 1 for a sample communication plan.
5. Likewise, all secondary schools are reiterated to conduct Career Guidance activities for the school year 2024-2025 pursuant to DepEd Order 41, s. 2015. These activities are essential for preparing learners to make informed life and career decisions.
