1. With reference to Regional Memorandum No. 137, s. 2024 re: 2024 Science Film Festival, this Division announces the conduct of **2024 Science Film Festival (SFF)** with the theme "**Net Zero and the Circular Economy**" from October 18 to December 1, 2024.
2. The festival aims to promote science literacy and enhance awareness of contemporary scientific, technological, and environmental issues through the medium of film and television.
3. In this regard, learners from both public and private elementary and secondary schools, particularly the Science, Technology and Engineering (STE), Special Science Elementary Schools (SSES) and Special Science Curriculum (SSC) are invited to watch the film intended for a particular level. Further, Science teachers are requested to download the films enumerated for a particular level ahead of the scheduled film viewing.
4. In addition to the list of films intended for the elementary level and secondary levels, there are also lists of films intended for the general public in which learners and teachers may also watch if interested.
5. There are 12 films, and 15 films intended for the elementary and secondary levels respectively. Science teachers are requested to submit a report through the link given from October 18, 2024 to December 1, 2024.
