ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

DOST-SELScholarship Program for INCOMING 1st year college students that aims to stimulate and entice talented Filipino youths to pursue lifetime productive careers in science and technology; and ensure a steady and adequate supply of qualified S&T human resources which can steer the country towards national progress.

TYPES OF SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS

- 1. MERIT (Republic Act No. 2067)
- · Formerly known as the NSD8 or NSTA Scholarship
- Started in 1958, and awarded to the top ranking qualifiers in the S&T Scholarship Exams.
- 2. RA 7687 (Republic Act No. 7687)
- · Science and Technology Scholarship Act of 1994
- · Awarded to talented and deserving students whose socio-economic status of their families do not exceed the set cut-off values of certain socio-economic indicators

WHO CAN APPLY?

- 1.1. Graduating Grade 12 male and female students in SY 2024-2025:
 - a. STEM STRAND: All students belonging to the STEM class
 - b. NON-STEM STRAND: Must be in the top 5% of the class based on Grade II ranking
- 1.2. Graduate of Grade 12 before the SY 2024-2025 and did not enroll in college yet:
 - a. STEM STRAND: All students belonging to the STEM class
 - b. NON-STEM STRAND: Must be in the top 5% of the graduating class
- 1.3. Graduate of high school before the K-12 Program. Must belong to the top 5% of the graduating
- 2. Must be natural-born Filipino citizen.
- 3. Must be of good moral character and in good health.
- 4. May have applied to the DOST-SEI Undergraduate Scholarship but did not qualify; OR may have qualified for the DOST-SEI Undergraduate Scholarship but did not avail of the award; OR have not applied to any DOST-SEI Undergraduate Scholarship Program.
- 5. Must NOT have earned any post-secondary (college or vocational) units.

Last Day of Online Application : 22 November 2024 and Uploading of Requirements

STEP 3: Filling out of Application Form and Uploading of Documentary Requirements


STEP 4: Selection of Test Center Location. (For successful applicant only)


