

1. As an output of the Online Workshop on the Transcription and Documentation of MIMAROPA Songs and knowing the importance of songs in the classroom, DepEd MIMAROPA Region through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) seeks to provide a resource material on the rich and unique songs of the region. It is intended for use in the teaching of music and culture not only in MAPEH classes but across learning areas.

2. To help teachers gain fuller understanding and appreciation of such, workshop and recording sessions shall be conducted on November 25-29, 2024 at a venue to be announced later. Specifically, the activity aims to:
