

**CALL FOR FY 2025 RESEARCH PROPOSALS FOR
 BASIC EDUCATION RESEARCH FUND**

1. In compliance with the Submission and Acceptance Process outlined in DepEd Order No. 16, s.2017 titled "Research Management Guidelines", this Office, through the Policy, Planning and Research Division (PPRD), announces the **Call for FY 2025 Research Proposals for Basic Education Research Fund (BERF)**.
2. Researchers are encouraged to focus on the priority research topics related to:
 - Learners' Macro Skills (Listening, Speaking, Reading & Writing)
 - Challenges on the latest PISA Results.

These topics should align with the themes of the Basic Education Research Agenda (BERA), which include:

- Teaching and Learnings
- Child Protection
- Human Resource Development and
- Governance.

However, key research topics from their Division's research agenda may also be taken into consideration by the researchers.

3. Interested research enthusiasts from the Regional Office (RO) may submit their proposals to the Regional Research Committee (RRC) through the PPRD which serves as the secretariat. Furthermore, Division Level research proposals shall be submitted to the Schools Division Research Committee (SDRC) through the Senior Education Program Specialist (SEPS) for Planning and Research.
4. Division Offices shall endorse top ten (10) initially evaluated proposals to the Regional Office. These proposals should be uploaded with complete attachments in e-copy (folder per research shall follow the suggested file name format: Last Name_First Name_Division) at the PPRD's Google Drive link: [https://drive.google.com/drive/folders/1W.../on or before March 31, 2025.](#)



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5. Research proposals with a passing rate of 70% and higher and endorsed by the SDRC shall be checked by the RRC Secretariat for compliance in accordance with RRC Checklist. These proposals shall then be forwarded to the RRC members for further evaluation. Kindly refer to the attached RMG Checklist for your guidance.
6. Researchers with approved research proposals shall be informed accordingly.
