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

CONDUCT OF THE 2025 MIMAROPA REGIONAL FESTIVAL OF TALENTS

TO : SCHOOLS DIVISION SUPERINTENDENTS

1. The Department of Education MIMAROPA Region, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division, announces the conduct of the 2025 MIMAROPA Regional Festival of Talents (RFOT) with the theme: ***"Nagninging na MIMAROPA, Handa para sa Bagong Pilipinas"***.
2. Relative to this, the following RFOT events will be conducted on the date and venue stated below:

3. The RFOT as a DepEd annual co-curricular activity aims to:
 - a. provide opportunities for basic education learners to showcase their talents and skills anchored on the learning competencies through exhibitions of their products, services, and performances for sustainable inclusive education;
 - b. gauge learning mastery and skills development of learners in accordance with learning standards; and,
 - c. select the region's representatives in the National Festival of Talents.
4. All events of the 2025 RFOT shall be conducted under the competition category.
5. The attached Guidelines will serve as the basis for conducting the 2025 MIMAROPA RFOT. However, the winning teams in the RFOT are advised to adhere to the guidelines on the conduct of the National Festival of Talents (NFOT) provided by the DepEd Central Office once they are officially released.

6. Participation in the **RFOT is voluntary**, and SDOs may decide on their level of participation based on their **financial capacity**. While encouraged, participation should be undertaken with due consideration of the **available resources and logistical readiness** of each SDO.
7. Participants in this activity are learners from public and private elementary and secondary schools who underwent division elimination or selection. They shall be accompanied by the official teacher-coaches and division officials in-charge of the event areas.
8. Learner-participants shall be allowed to participate in only one event category during the RFOT. They shall also secure the parent/guardian's consent for participation in the event. Likewise, the SDO shall ensure that the participants are covered/insured during the duration of the activity.
9. Pintahusay participants are required to bring their painting canvas with primer and frame (24x36 inches) and painting easel.
10. To ensure the safety, health, and well-being of all RFOT participants and delegates, strict observance of minimum health protocols shall be implemented within all activity premises.
11. The top three (3) winners in all contest events shall be recognized except for Special Needs Education where awards shall be based on the provided rubrics. They shall receive medals and certificates while their teacher-coaches shall receive certificates of recognition. Non-winning participants and coaches, on the other hand, shall receive a certificate of participation.
12. An orientation meeting with the SDO counterparts shall be conducted by each Regional Office Event Area focal person prior to the conduct of events (See Enclosure 4 for the schedule of the meeting). Additionally, a meeting with the members of the RO Technical Working Group (RO-TWG) will be conducted on February 5, 2025, at 10:00 AM in the Learning Resource Room.
13. The official division delegation will consist of 117 participants. Delegates are expected to arrive at the venue on or before 3:00 PM on February 12, 2025, ahead of the opening program. The division focal person is responsible for encoding the list of participants on or before January 31, 2025, through this link: <https://tinyurl.com/32p47hce>.
14. The board and lodging, transportation, and other incidental/related expenses of the participants shall be charged against the school Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) or other eligible sources of funds while the honorarium, food and accommodation of the judges and RO personnel, as well as supplies and materials, medals, and plaques, shall be shouldered by the Regional MOOE and CO downloaded Program Support Funds. All expenditures shall be subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
15. The SDOs have the option to stay at the contest venue or arrange an alternative accommodation. However, the SDOs must ensure the safety of their delegation, organize transportation, provide food, and guarantee their timely arrival at the contest venues.

16. For SDOs opting to stay at the contest venue, they must coordinate directly with the venue management to arrange their accommodations and/or food provisions.
