SUBJECT: **SUPPORT FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE GULAYAN SA PUSO
NG PILIPINAS (G2Ps) PROGRAM**

DATE: February 25, 2025

1. In line with SP Resolution No. 1641 s. 2024 and Provincial Ordinance No. 236 s. 2024, which establishes the "Gulayan sa Puso ng Pilipinas" (G2Ps) Program in the Province of Marinduque, the Department of Education- Schools Division of Marinduque fully supports this initiative. This program aims to enhance food security, promote sustainable agriculture, and provide economic opportunities through vegetable gardening in schools and communities.
2. As such, all public schools within the Division are encouraged to actively participate in the implementation of this program by:
 - (a) Establishing and maintaining school-based vegetable gardens to support the supplementary feeding program and promote eating habits among students;
 - (b) Integrating concepts of sustainable agriculture, nutrition, and environmental protection into the curriculum through Edukasyong Pantahanan at Pangkabuhayan (EPP), Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE), and other related subjects;
 - (c) Coordinating with local government units (LGUs), the Provincial Agriculture Office, and other stakeholders for technical and material support such as organic fertilizers and seedlings;
 - (d) Encouraging community participation, including parents and barangay officials, in sustaining school and home based gardening initiatives; and



(e) Reporting best practices, progress and challenges in the implementation of the program to the Schools Division Office through Gulayan sa Paaralan Program (GPP) for proper monitoring and evaluation

3. All concerned personnel are expected to facilitate the smooth implementation of this program and ensure its sustainability within their respective areas of responsibility.

4. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with the contents of this memorandum are desired.
