



SDOs and schools are encouraged to organize their own cliniquing sessions without overlapping with the region's online and face-to-face schedules to equip the learner-participants with skills and confidence to secure strong standing in the competition.
7. For the face-to-face training-workshop, each participant is required to bring his/her own laptop, and extension cord, as training requirements. Furthermore, it is essential that participants have their Identification Cards readily available which will be provided by the billeting school.
8. The travel and other incidental expenses of the learner-participants will be downloaded to their respective SDOs, while for the coaches, SPAs, and Division EPSs, their travel expenses will be chargeable against local funds or other eligible fund source subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Food relative to this activity will be provided by the DepEd MIMAROPA Regional Office.
9. The honorarium, travel, food and accommodation of the invited trainers will be provided by the regional office subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
10. For documentation purposes, photos taken during this activity will be used solely for informational purposes and not for commercial use. Additionally, written consent will be obtained from the parents of the learner-participants before any photos are taken and must be submitted to clmd.mimaroparegion@deped.gov.ph.
