

SUBJECT: **POST-IMPLEMENTATION REVIEW ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM FOR SY 2024-2025**

DATE: April 30, 2025

1. In line with the Schools Division of Marinduque's unwavering commitment to promote a holistic and continually improve the implementation of the School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP), a Post Implementation Review on the Implementation of School-Based Feeding Program will be conducted to assess the effectiveness, gather insights, observations and recommendations during the implementation of the program for School Year 2024-2025 on June 4-5, 2025 at SDO Marinduque Conference Hall, Malusak, Boac Marinduque.

2. This activity aims to:

- a. identify strengths and best practices in the current implementation of the SBFP;
- b. address challenges encountered during the program implementation period;
- c. gather suggestions and strategize mechanism for efficient and effective implementation, delivery, logistics and monitoring of School-Based Feeding Program in the current year; and
- d. present updates and relevant information on the implementation of the School-Based Feeding Program for the current school year.

3. Participants in this activity are the School Heads of 183 Public Elementary Schools, two (2) members of the District Inspectorate Team, nine (9) Public Schools

District Supervisors, twenty (20) Health and Nutrition personnel and ten (10) SDO personnel concerned.

4. The participants are advised to answer the pre-registration link to be forwarded by the district nurses.
5. There will be a provision of snacks and meal for the participants.
6. Program Matrix and Schedule of Orientation are found in Enclosure 1 respectively.
7. Participants shall be scheduled in two (2) batches to ensure proper accommodation found in Enclosure 2.
8. The link is provided for the school heads, inspectorate team members and nurses in each district to collect data on issues, concerns, and best practices during the implementation of the program outlined in Enclosure No. 3. Responses must be submitted on or before May 21, 2025.
9. All participants are directed to strictly comply with the minimum health and safety protocols during the activity.
10. Immediate and wide dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum is desired.
